Corps Campaigning

- This opportunity will be limited to SPB, Yell Leader, and Class President candidates
- Candidates may speak to each outfit on the morning of Monday, March 24th at 6:00am
- Any candidate wishing to participate should notify the Corps Public Relations Officer no later than Friday, March 7 at 12:00 noon

Corps Campaigning

- 5:45 -- Candidates and representatives arrive at the Arches of the Quad (at least 10 people total)
- 5:50 -- Candidates and representatives are split up into 10 groups (1 group per dorm)
- 5:55 -- Groups are escorted to their respective dorms by cadets
- 6:00 -- Candidates and representatives begin speaking to each outfit. Each candidate will be given two (2) minutes to explain why they are the best candidate and take any questions.
- 6:40 -- Estimated time that candidates should be finished speaking to outfits, depending on the number of candidates campaigning
- 7:00 -- Corps formation/breakfast in Duncan. Candidates (and no more than 3 other representatives, please) will be welcome to walk around Duncan to speak to various cadets but should not interfere with the training environment and will be required by Dining Services to pay for a meal to enter Duncan

Fliers for Corps Dorms

- The same group of candidates applies
- All fliers (40 in total; 4 per dorm, 10 dorms) should be turned into the Corps Guard room at the north end of Dorm 2 (Kiest Hall, next to the Arches) by Friday, March 7 at 12:00 noon.
 - Any fliers turned in after that time will not be accepted.
- The fliers should be submitted in an opaque envelope with instructions written on the outside to have them placed in the Corps Public Relations Officer's Box in the Corps Staff hallway.
- The fliers will be posted on the evening of Sunday, March 16 and removed after the announcement of the results, unless that candidate will be in the runoff elections.
